4. Carry cellphones and/or walkie talkies

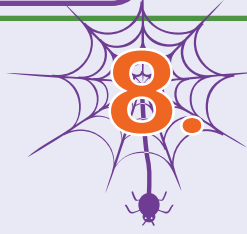
5. PUT REFLECTIVE TAPE ON COSTUMES AND BAGS



6. Use flashlights and glowsticks



7. WALK, DON'T RUN



8. Walk only on sidewalks

9. WALK ON THE FAR EDGE OF THE ROAD FACING ONCOMING TRAFFIC



10. LOOK BOTH WAYS BEFORE CROSSING THE STREET



11. NEVER CROSS BETWEEN PARKED CARS

12. BE ALERT!



13. VISIT ONLY WELL-LIT HOUSES



14. NEVER enter someone else's home or car



15. Don't accept rides from strangers

16. COSTUME ACCESSORIES SHOULD BE SHORT AND FLEXIBLE

17. WEAR WELL-FITTING COSTUMES, MASKS AND SHOES



18. FLAME-RESISTANT COSTUMES

19. Choose face paint and make-up instead of masks, if possible

20. ALWAYS TEST MAKE-UP AND FACE PAINT IN A SMALL AREA FIRST

21. EXAMINE ALL TREATS BEFORE EATING

22. NEVER EAT TREATS MADE BY STRANGERS OR UNWRAPPED CANDY
